

Who is Your Audience?

1st - The teaching is not that we should hide our good deeds. (189)

2nd - Our intent is determined by what we want and expect from our action. (190)

God does not like to be present where He is not wanted. He knows when He is wanted and when He is not. He does not intrude, generally speaking. (190)

Is Jesus teaching us to go public or stay private?


The 1st Teaching God looks good

Disciplines as a Means of Grace...

1. GIVING

2. PRAYING

3. FASTING

...to practice what Jesus taught!



Disciplines as a Means of Grace

1. GIVING — Matthew 6:1-4

"Hypocrite" - Used 17 times by Jesus (def.) "an actor, one being on stage" (191)

Left Hand/Right Hand

Generous people do what they do naturally, often automatically. (192)



Disciplines as a Means of Grace (continued)

2. PRAYING — Matthew 6:5-15

Again, the ego swells, the soul shrivels. (193, 191)

Kingdom praying and its efficacy is entirely a matter of the innermost heart being totally open and honest before God.



In apprenticeship to Jesus...He teaches us how to be in prayer what we are in life and how to be in life what we are in prayer.

(195)

Disciplines as a Means of Grace (cont'd)

3. FASTING – Matthew 6:16-18

Jesus indicates that physical nourishment too was available directly from spiritual sources. (198)

Nourishing ourselves on the person of Jesus. (199)

"Fasting enables us to remain sweet and strong when we don't get our way."

The Discipline of Secrecy will help us break the grip of human opinion over our souls and our actions.

As Gathered Christians...

Jesus lays His finger upon a primary cause of their ineffectiveness as schools of eternal living. (201)

If our lives and works are to be of the Kingdom of God, we must not have human approval as a primary or even major aim. (202)
