




What Jesus Knew: Our God Bathed World

Heaven is strictly out of sight for us.

The damage done to our practical faith in Christ and in His government-at-hand by confusing Heaven with a place in distant outer space, or even beyond space, is incalcuable. Of course, God is there too. But instead of Heaven and God also being always present with us, as Jesus shows them to be, we invariably take them to be locked far away and, most likely, at a much later time - not here and not now. And we should then be surprised to feel ourselves alone?

"Living Space" not "Outer Space"

At no place, does our contemporary mindset more strongly conflict with the life and good news of Jesus than over the understanding of space. If we are to make sense of Jesus' teaching and practice of the Kingdom of the Heavens, we must understand what spirit and the spiritual are and how they are in space.

What Jesus Knew: Our God Bathed World

Me: a Spiritual Being with a Physical Body

You will not find in my body my thoughts, feelings, intellect, creativity, character.

My Eyes, Face & Hands - my Body - is where I become present to others.

God: a Spiritual Being present in Space

Physical Objects & Natural Law - is where God relates.

God Wants to Be Seen

Love always wants to be known.

Seeing is no simple thing. The practice of seeing God and God's world through a process of seeking and growing in intimacy with Him.

The Heavens progressively open to us as our character and understanding are increasingly attuned to the realities of God's rule from the Heavens.

So we should assume space is anything but empty.
